

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE HOUSING FOR SENIORS
IN RIVERDALE, IL**

The Housing Authority of the County of Cook (HACC) is proposing to Amend its 2009 Senior Designated Housing Plan to include thirty –five (35) units of senior housing at the RIVERDALE SENIOR, LLC, located at 335 West 138th Street, in the Village of Riverdale, IL.

The Riverdale Senior, LLC is a vacant building owned by Turnstone Development, the nonprofit development instrumentality of HACC. This building has been vacant for several years. Redevelopment of this building will bring new vitality to the community and will serve elderly low income persons, age 62 and over.

Public Housing residents and the public may submit comments on the Draft Amendment to the Senior Designated Housing Plan (SDHP) during the public comment period. The 30 day comment period begins **July 7, 2010 (8:30 A.M) and ends August 6, 2010 (4:30 P.M)** All comments must be received by 4:30 PM on August 6, 2010.
